### FIRST AID MEASURES

EYE CONTACT : IMMEDIATELY FLUSH EYES WITH LOTS OF RUNNING WATER FOR 15 MINUTES, LIFTING THE UPPER AND LOWER EYELIDS TO ENSURE FLUSHING OF THE ENTIRE SURFACE. SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION AS NEEDED.  
INHALATION : REMOVE TO FRESH AREA. IF NOT BREATHING, GIVE ARTIFICIAL RESPIRATION. CALL PHYSICIAN.  
INGESTION : DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. DRINK LARGE QUANTITIES OF WATER AND SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION IMMEDIATELY. NEVER GIVE ANYTHING BY MOUTH TO AN UNCONSCIOUS PERSON.  
SKIN CONTACT : WASH SKIN WITH LOTS OF WATER. IF IRRITATION OCCURS AND PERSISTS SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION AS NEEDED.
