

SKIN CONTACT: SHORT, SINGLE EXPOSURE MAY CAUSE IRRITATION TO SKIN. PROLONGED LIQUID CONTACT WILL BURN TISSUE.

FIRST AID MEASURES

EYE CONTACT : IMMEDIATELY FLUSH EYES WITH LOTS OF RUNNING WATER FOR AT LEAST 15 MINUTES, LIFTING THE UPPER AND LOWER EYELIDS TO ENSURE FLUSHING OF THE ENTIRE SURFACE. SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION IF NEEDED.

INHALATION : REMOVE TO FRESH AREA. IF NOT BREATHING, GIVE MOUTH TO MOUTH RESUSCITATION. IF BREATHING IS DIFFICULT, ADMINISTER OXYGEN. CALL A PHYSICIAN.

INGESTION : DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. DRINK LARGE QUANTITIES OF WATER AND TRANSPORT VICTIM TO MEDICAL FACILITY IMMEDIATELY. NEVER GIVE ANYTHING BY MOUTH TO AN UNCONSCIOUS PERSON.

SKIN CONTACT : WASH SKIN WITH LOTS OF SOAP AND WATER. REMOVE CONTAMINATED CLOTHING AND SHOES AND WASH BEFORE REUSE. IF IRRITATION OCCURS AND PERSISTS SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION.

STABILITY: STABLE
 INCOMPATIBILITY (MATERIALS TO AVOID): AVOID MIXING OF THIS MATERIAL WITH STRONG ACIDS OR OXIDIZERS.
 HAZARDOUS POLYMERIZATION: WILL NOT OCCUR
 CONDITIONS TO AVOID: EXCESSIVE HEAT AND ANY CONTAMINATION.

CLEAN-UP PROCEDURES: ONLY TRAINED AND PROPERLY PROTECTED PERSONNEL SHOULD BE INVOLVED IN SPILLED CLEAN-UP OPERATIONS. MOP UP AND PLACE MATERIAL IN SEALABLE CONTAINERS FOR DISPOSAL. FLUSH CONTAMINATED AREAS WITH WATER.

RECOMMENDED WASTE DISPOSAL METHOD: DISPOSE OF IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL APPLICABLE FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL REGULATIONS.

RESPIRATORY PROTECTION : NONE.
 EYE PROTECTION : CHEMICAL GOGGLES.
 PROTECTIVE CLOTHING : RUBBER GLOVES AND FULL LENGTH CLOTHING.

HYGIENIC PRACTICES IN HANDLING STORING: WASH THOROUGHLY AFTER HANDLING.

PRECAUTION TO BE TAKEN IN HANDLING AND STORING: STORE IN COOL, DRY, VENTILATED AREAS.

DISPOSAL OF EMPTY CONTAINER: EMPTY CONTAINERS SHOULD BE TRIPLE RINSED WITH WATER AND DISPOSED OF PURSUANT TO LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS.
